



The Values cards can be used to help small groups bring curiosity and begin to reflect on the values that they hold.

Remember, when reflecting in this way, the 'Why?' is where the treasure is!

TED questions can be a great tool to use to help open up discussion and encourage reflective thinking.

When used as a group resource - it might be helpful to work with a smaller sample of 5-7 cards.

Here are some questions to help kick start your thinking and discussion. It is important to remember that there are no right or wrong answers here.

Begin by choosing 5-7 cards from the deck and placing them face up in the centre of the group

Explain that
Describe it to me

- Are there any words you haven't heard of before?
- Can you describe what each card means?

- Which cards stand out to you? Why?
- Are there any that make you feel uncomfortable? Why?
- In what ways have you seen these values lived out at school or college, or in friends or family?

- Are there any cards that feel more positive or acceptable than others?
- Are there any values that you particularly appreciate in friends?
- Can you rank these in order of importance?

- Which of these values do we see lived out in the life of Jesus?
- Do any of these words remind you of something you have read in the bible?
- Do you think there are any of these words that Jesus might feel are more important than others?
